Andrea Carnaghi is full professor of Social Psychology at the University of Trieste (11/E3 - PSICOLOGIA SOCIALE, DEL LAVORO E DELLE ORGANIZZAZIONI, PSIC-03/A - Psicologia sociale). He received his Phd at the Catholic University of Louvain, Louvain-La-Neuve (Belgium) in 2004. From 2004 until 2006, he held a Post-doc position at the University of Padova in the Department of Development and Socialization. In 2006 he was appointed as an Assistant Professor at the University of Trieste, in 2014 he was promoted to Associate Professor, and in 2020 he was promoted to Full professor.
