How to reach us

The road network directly connects the city of Gorizia to the A4 motorway (Turin-Milan-Venice) and northward to the A23 motorway (Vienna and Munich), European Corridor 5.

The newly built H4 motorway in Slovenia has opened an important road axis connecting Ljubljana, Zagreb, Budapest and Belgrade.

By plane

The Conference Center is only 20km away from the International Airport of Friuli Venezia Giulia - Ronchi dei Legionari (TRS). Just an hour away by car, you can also find the airports of Venice "Marco Polo" (VCE), Treviso "Antonio Canova" (TSF), and Ljubljana "Aerodrome Ljubljana" (LJU).

Conference Center is committed. The Center is designed as a meeting place where the human element is the focal point and mutual exchange is encouraged. The Conference Center is also provided with technological equipment allowing a dynamic drive towards the future.





Located in the historic building of via Alviano in the city of Gorizia, today the Conference Center hosts one of the campus locations of the University of Trieste.

The building is spread over two levels and features an elegant entrance, serving as a well-equipped reception area for guests. The corridor leads to the main hall which, with its round shape, has two possible arrangements: one follows the circular floor plan of the hall and can hold up to 100 people, while the other, hosting up to 250 people, serves as conference room with an elegant central speakers' table, 28 simultaneous interpretation booths, as well as a fully equipped Control room.

There are also several smaller rooms, designed for performing additional activities such as workshops and meetings held alongside the ongoing conference, as well as rooms for press offices and press conferences, exhibition and multi-function areas.

The adjoining wing features other rooms for both administrative and logistic activities carried out by the University of Trieste.
